

# Radioactive Waste

Any waste material or product, for which no use is foreseen, containing or contaminated with radionuclides in concentrations or levels exceeding those established by legislation.

## Classification

The most common is due to its activity level and the half-life of the isotopes it contains.



## Transport

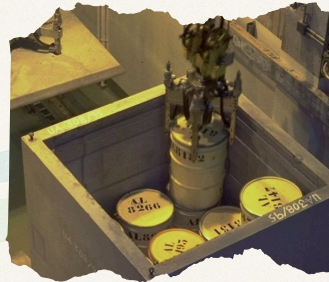
Worldwide, around 2% of international shipments are nuclear and radioactive materials.
